Where should full

Full stops are always used to show where a sentence has ended.

I love to eat cake.

I want chips for dinner.

Ben and Sam went on
holiday to Spain.

When we write more than one sentence we need to know where to put the full stop otherwise the sentence doesn't make sense.

There are 2 ideas here. Tad by herself
and Tad in the pond. To break up the
sentence we have to put the full stop after
'herself'. We have to remember to add
another capital letter after the full stop.
