Today is World Book Day and I thought it would be lovely to celebrate reading all day through various activities! Below is a list of activities to complete during the day.

- Make your own bookmark. Templates have been provided or you can make your own.
- Share your favourite book with a brother, sister, adult or a pet if you have one! The book can be fiction or non-fiction. Once you have done this, complete the book review template or you can copy this onto your own paper at home.
- At 10.30am we are all going to watch a live session from different authors. This is for 4+ so younger siblings can also take part. Use this link and hopefully it will go live on Thursday!

- I would like children to make their own books and write their own stories! Instructions have been provided. The first set of instructions are for an easier book. You can cut out the 8 squares to turn it into a mini book or your child can draw and write in each square. If you fancy a challenge, continue onto the next template where you can make a house book!
- Once finished, use the story board for your child to plan their story by drawing pictures. It can be about anything! Then they can write one or 2 sentences for each picture in their book. If you have created the house book, your child can write out their story on a separate piece of paper. They can then decorate the house based on their story.
- Please email the written story and keep the story books or story houses so your child can share this with us on Friday. Please note, this may be a longer session tomorrow as it will be the

last one for home learning and I would like each child at home to talk for 5 minutes and share their stories with us.

- Finally to end World Book Day, use the link to watch a story being read aloud. Your child can choose from any in the list and you can listen to more than one if you wish.
