English

This half-term we are focusing on 'All About Me' and growing. In English, we will be looking at writing short sentences to form a story and stories with repetitive phrases. Then use the story writing frame for your child to draw a picture for each caption. Your child can also draw the pictures straight onto paper or in a book making sure there are lines ready for writing. Only email on Friday once all sentences are written.

RE

Explain to your child that this half term we are going to look at why Easter matters to Christians. How do we know it is Spring? Go on a Spring walk or look in the garden for clues for Spring. Remind chn about using their senses to help them. What can they see, hear and feel?

Explain that Easter is a festival that happens in Spring time to remember a very important part of the Bible.

Remind chn that Christians celebrate the birth of Jesus at Christmas time. Christians believe that Jesus is God who has come down to Earth. What Jesus did from when he was born until he died can be found in the Bible. The Easter story is one of these which is sad but then happy.
