

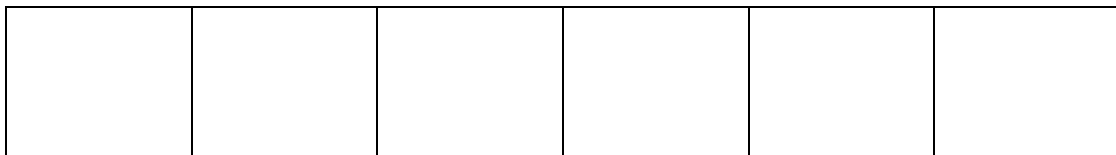
Thursday

Maths

Today we will be looking at finding number bonds in order to a number within 11-20 and 20. Use the 'Finding number bonds in order' pdf to go through the instructions. Your child will need practical objects for this. You may use the relevant sheet for your child to record their number bonds or you can copy it onto paper or in a book. Once completed email both activities.

Letters and Sounds - no photo/image required to send back
