

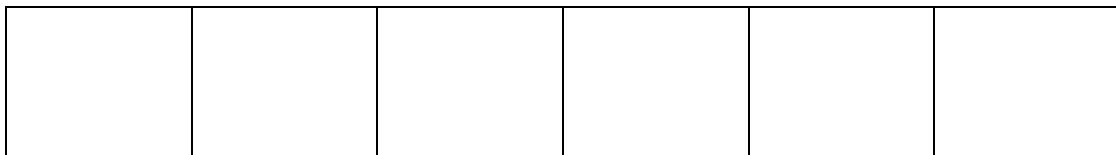

Maths

To finish off our number bond work, today we will be looking at finding a missing number bond to 20. Your child can use number lines or objects. Use 'Finding a missing number bond to 20' pdf to go through the learning. Complete the relevant sheet and email it.

Letters and Sounds - no photo/image required to send back

Letters and Sounds are now live lessons every morning on Teams. Please ensure your child attends this session as it is very important for them to continue to learn how to read and write. Your child will need phoneme frames drawn on paper or in a book. It looks like this. They will need at least 6 of these drawn separately.



If your child is in Mrs White's group, they have now finished practising phase 4 words and will continue with the live lessons on Teams every morning.

Your child will need to verbally read words, sounds and answer questions. They will need paper and a pencil.

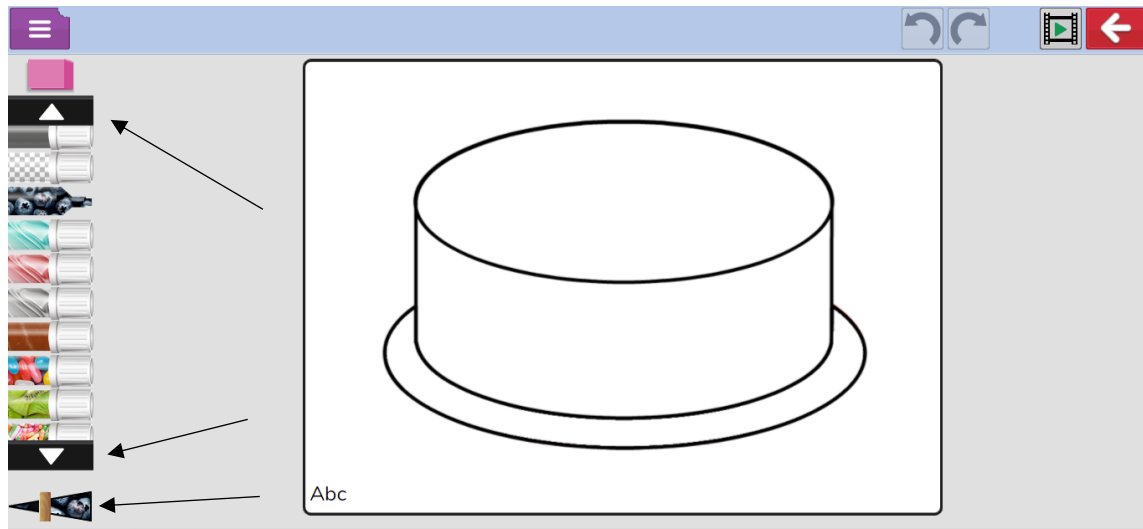
History

To consolidate learning, I would like you to play a Great Fire of London board game! Use the resources provided to play the game! You can use your own dice and counters at home - please don't feel like you have to print/use everything.

ICT

The next few lessons are going to be about learning how to follow instructions on the computer/tablet. Explain to your child when they follow instructions, they will get what they are doing correct. When computers follow instructions, this is called an 'algorithm'.

Open up the 'birthday cake' 2Do and tell your child to complete painting it using the paint colours on the side. Please explain to them how to scroll up and down for different colours/patterns and how to change the paint width. Once completed, make sure it is saved and handed in.



Now tell your child they are going to do it again with a different picture but this time you are going to give them an algorithm (instruction) to paint a bird. They will have to listen to the instructions carefully and choose the right colours. Open up the 'bird' 2Do and read these instructions out loud for your child to complete.

1. Paint the beak yellow
2. Paint the head red
3. Paint the tummy dark green
4. Paint the wing dark blue
5. Paint the tail orange
6. Paint the legs yellow
7. Paint the middle of the body turquoise
8. Paint the back light blue
9. Add an eye

Once finished, save it and hand in. Explain to your child computers can't think so humans need to give computers exact instructions so they can do things for us.

As a challenge, there is one more 2Do where your child can paint a Hansel and Gretel House using the instructions below. Read each instruction for your child to complete and please remind them about scrolling up and down to find the different paint effects. I will leave comments for all pictures completed once handed in.

1. Paint the chimney using cookie dough
2. Paint the roof using jellybeans
3. Paint the door using chocolate
4. Paint the walls using sprinkles
5. Leave the windows unpainted

Have a great half-term! You have all been brilliant with the home learning so far and I really appreciate the efforts going into teaching your child at home.
