

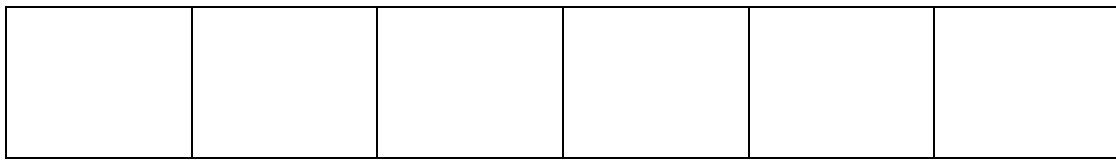
Monday

Maths

Today I would like your child to recap drawing tens and ones so that we are confident and all using the same method in future lessons. Use 'How to draw tens and ones' pdf to go through the learning. The activity can be completed in their home learning book or on spare paper. Please take a photo and email once complete.

Letters and Sounds - no photo/image required to send back

Letters and Sounds are now live lessons every morning on Teams. Please ensure your child attends this session as it is very important for them to continue to learn how to read and write. Your child will need phoneme frames drawn on paper or in a book. It looks like this. They will need at least 6 of these drawn separately.

Your child will need to verbally read words, sounds and answer questions. They will need paper and a pencil.

History

The next 2 weeks we will be looking at The Great Fire of London! To begin our learning, I would like you to use 'The Great Fire of London' pdf to read the information to your child and discuss the pictures. Let your child ask questions or help them to answer/discuss questions they may have. Then if you have access to GoogleMaps, I would like you to go on a virtual adventure to find Pudding Lane, The Monument and The River Thames! To consolidate learning, I would like your child to draw a picture for the matching labels on the sheet.

RE

Remind your child we are learning about what God is like. Use the link to show a new parable (story) from the Bible called 'Jonah and the fish'.

Afterwards, explain that Jonah was told by God to go to the place of Nineveh (Nin-a-va) to tell them they were going to be in big trouble if they didn't start worshipping God because they were doing a lot of wrong things. Jonah didn't want to do this because the city was so bad, so he turned away from doing it. Instead of God being angry at Jonah, God gave him another chance to go and do the right thing by keeping him inside the fish to give Jonah time to think and ask God for forgiveness and to help him get out. Christians believe that God is slow to show anger and is full of love.

Use the RE discussion sheet to go through the questions and write down your child's responses. Then use the drawing activity sheet to read the captions to your child and they can draw and colour a matching picture to show their understanding.
