Your child will need to verbally read words, sounds and answer questions. They will need paper and a pencil.

English

Use the 'The Three Billy Goats Gruff' pdf to read through the story. Use the muddled-up pictures for your child to cut out and stick in the correct order. (If your child has an allocated place at school and is attending this week, please read the story only. We will be cutting and sticking the pictures on Tuesday along with writing). Please make sure there is enough space for writing. If you are using plain paper, please draw lines for your child to write on so that they can form letters starting from the line. If you do not have a printer, your child can draw the pictures themselves. Use 'Picture 1' pdf to go through the learning and then let your child write. Some children will write a simple sentence, but most children should be able to write more sentences. Please note, writing needs to be emailed on Friday to me rather than a page each day. This way I can read the story in one go for your child.

RE

Use the link to show the parable (story) of 'The Prodigal Son' again.

Explain to your child in the story the father is like God who forgives us when we have done something wrong. Ask your child how Christian people would describe God. Write these down for your child.

Ask your child what happens at school if someone does something wrong? Does the teacher forgive that person in the end?

Ask your child what happens at home if they do something wrong? Do parents/grown-ups forgive them in the end? How do they know when they have been forgiven by their parent/grown up?

Ask your child if someone did something wrong to them, is it a good thing to forgive them? Why do we need to forgive?

Explain to your child sometimes people pray to God to ask for forgiveness when they have done something wrong. There are 4 types of prayers; praise (prayer of love), saying sorry, saying thank you and asking for something.

Use the 'prayers' pdf to show these prayer characters and tell your child we are only going to look at Suzy Sorry and Peter Praise. Use the pdf to go through the activity. Complete and email it.

Finally, ask your child is forgiveness just for Christians or other people too? Discuss this.
