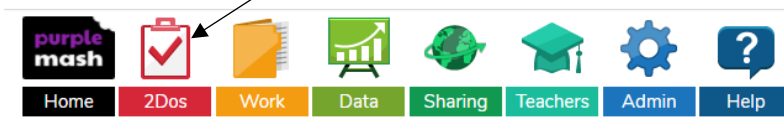

Your child will need to verbally read words, sounds and answer questions. They will need paper and a pencil.

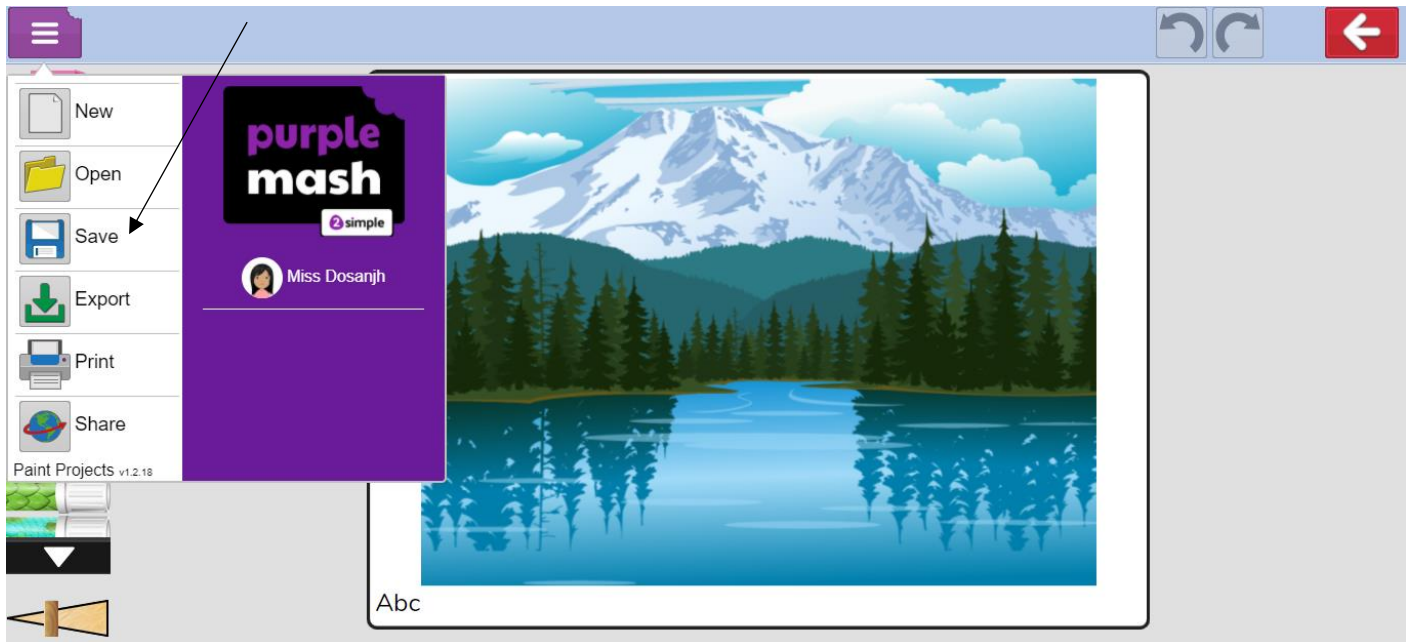
ICT
