Dear Parents / Carers,

We hope you have all kept safe and well during the summer holidays. We are so pleased to be back at school with our new classes and are excited to begin school routines once again!

As you may be aware, school is slightly different and there have been some changes to the things we would normally do. Please take the time to read through this letter carefully. If you have any questions please feel free to see me at the end of the day.

- Homework will not be provided to take home, complete and bring back to school. Instead, we will be setting online home tasks through various forms such as PurpleMash, Youtube videos, online games, etc. Where possible we will mark what we have access to. We do expect homework to be completed on time so that children can progress with their learning. If you find accessing home learning difficult, please come and see me.

- Our PE day will be every Wednesday. Please dress your child in tracksuit bottoms, a t-shirt and a zip-up hooded top with comfortable trainers. They must come into school on this day wearing their PE kit and will stay in their kit for the day.

- We will be reading with your child on a one-to-one basis during school time until we have established a way which is safe to send books home to read and return. We will keep a record of your child's reading progress which will be kept in school.

- Children need their own labelled bottle of water as the drinking fountain is out of bounds.
- Children can still choose a hot dinner if they wish or bring a packed lunch to school.
- Fruit will be provided from 7th September onwards. You may choose to provide your child with a fruit snack before this date.

Please could you also provide a set of spare socks, tights, pants, trousers, etc in a small labelled bag in case your child has an accident. This will be kept in school and sent home when needed.

As part of the transition from Early Years to Year 1 and to ease the children into school routines again, we have set up our classroom where children will be moving to different stations and activities within the room inside and outdoors throughout the day.

If you have any questions, the best time to see us is after school once children have been dismissed.
