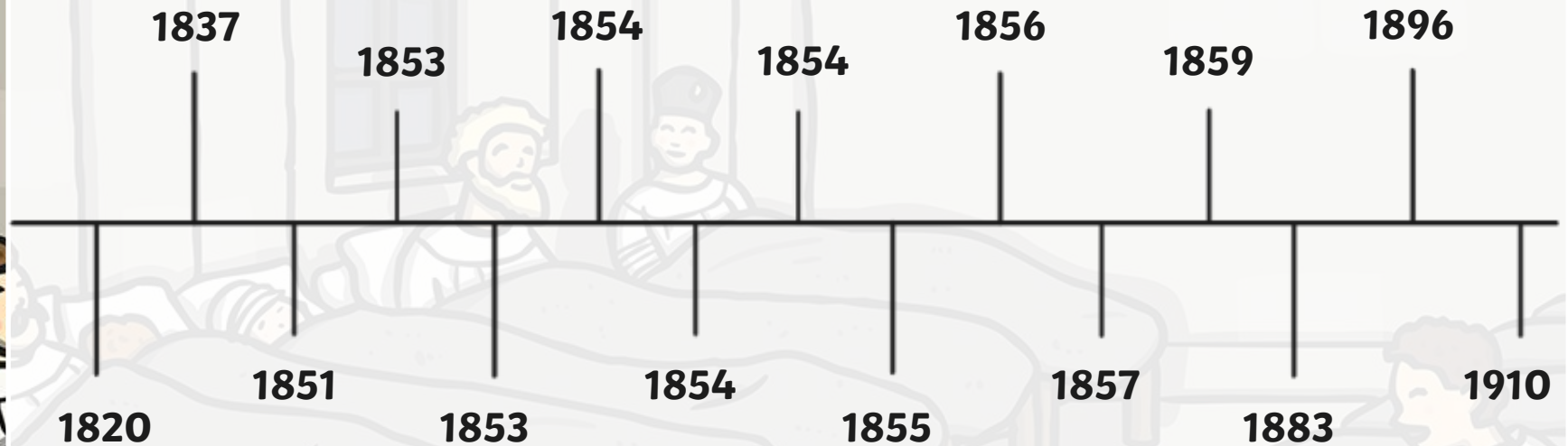


Florence Nightingale

Florence Nightingale was born on the 12th of May in 1820.



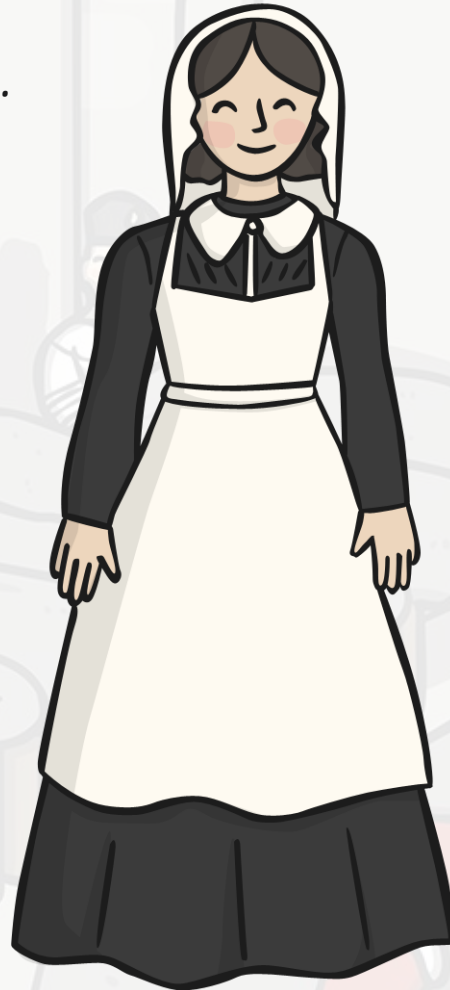
1837

1855

People gave lots of money to the Nightingale Fund for the training of nurses.



1856

The Crimean War ended.



1857

Florence returned to England as a heroine.



1859

The Nightingale Training School was opened.



1883

Queen Victoria awarded Florence the Royal Red Cross.



1896

Florence became so ill she couldn't leave her bed.



1910

Florence Nightingale died on the 13th of August.
