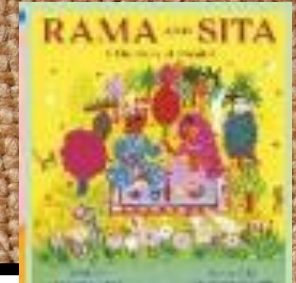


EYFS Curriculum Information

Autumn 2 - Down in the Woods

Our topic in Autumn 2 will be based upon seasonal changes and special events.

Throughout this topic, the children will continue to celebrate what makes each person unique. They will be identifying feelings and knowing the importance of showing kindness and care towards others. We will be celebrating different events coming up this half-term, exploring changes in our local environment and looking at special places in different communities.



We will continue to read stories to give children opportunities to talk about their own experiences linked to the books we are focusing on and discuss similarities and differences within their own lives.



In our Maths sessions, we will finish off learning about 1, 2 and 3 and move onto circles and triangles and describing position using different words. We will cover the numbers 4 and 5 as well as looking at 4-sided shapes before ending the term with day and night.
