Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back! We hope you have had a wonderful summer break. It is lovely having the children back in school. Please take some time to read the Year Four information below.

Our topic for this term is **Anglo-Saxons and Vikings**. Our knowledge organisers are on our class page, alongside any other information we need to share with you.

Teaching staff

Teaching Staff – Mrs Greer (Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday) and Mrs Mitchell (Wednesday, Thursday and Friday). Mrs Langton will be our classroom support.

PE Days – Mondays and Fridays

Your child will need to continue to wear their PE kit to school on these days, **INSTEAD** of their school uniform. We will have PE inside on Monday and outside (weather permitting) on Friday. We suggest your child wears their **school PE t-shirt and shorts** underneath a tracksuit/joggers (**NO** football kit or LOGOs please). Please ensure your child also wears trainers.

Spelling Tests

Once your child is settled into Year 4, spellings will be given out on a **Wednesday**, with a test every **Monday**. Please encourage and support your child to learn these each week. They will also be available to practise on Spelling Shed.

Reading

Children will be able to select a reading book from school, as usual. Please sign your child's reading diary when you have heard them read, as well as to confirm they have finished a book and wish to change it.

Times tables

Specific times tables will be handed out to learn every Wednesday and tested on a Monday. Please also encourage your child to keep up with their 'Times Tables Rock Star' progress (a few minutes 3-5 times a week minimum).

As you may be aware, at the end of Year 4, the children will sit a statutory multiplication tables check (MTC). We will keep you updated regarding this.

Homework - Online learning

In addition to spellings, times tables and daily reading; weekly homework tasks will be online. You will find information about this on our class page.
