## **Reading**

Please keep reading as much as possible at home as it has a huge impact on pupils reading and writing at school.

Continue to encourage pupils to put their reading books in the box so we can change their book or check how many times they have read. Please date and sign your child's diary every time you hear them read. Children do not need to finish their book in one day; they can read a few pages each night. If, by Friday, your child has been heard reading three or more times during the week, they will receive one house point. We will monitor reading at home and aim to read with each child once per week in school.
