

Year 5 Homework due Monday 5 Oct 2020

Your task is set on Purple Mash as a 2Do. It is to design a comic story, starring a superhero, to give a message to Year 4 and Year 5 children about staying safe online.

The message in your comic story will be one of the messages from our lesson with the SMART crew videos. They were:



Chapter 1: What should you accept?

You need to plan who will be in the story – look at the clip art available – at least one child and one superhero. Choose which message your story will be about.



Chapter 2: What is Reliable?

I have started the very first part of **my** comic story called The Game, with some text, a pic of a boy called Amir and a speech bubble. It is going to be about that fact that Amir thinks he is getting messages from a boy like him



Chapter 3: What should you keep safe?

but it turns out to be someone much older who is trying to trick him. It is about the message – Who should you tell? I have set this as a 2Do **for you to look at** – NOT for you to carry on with mine!

I expect your comic to have a cover and one page of 4 comic boxes – you can do more!

Remember to **save your work every 5 mins** so if your device crashes, the work is not lost!

I will put the stories up on the class display board in Purple Mash for Year 4 and 5 to be able to read and admire.

We will have a look at each other's comic stories in our Computing lesson on Monday afternoon.

This is a **Quick Start Guide** to the app and it is also in the Class Work folder.

Using 2Publish+

As soon as you start, click purple page in corner – **save** and name your work in 'My Work' folder

You start with the cover. Click the + to add pages (of 4 spaces) to the comic.

Click **clip art** and then the drop-down arrow for a list of sets of pictures eg superheroes, characters, computers

You can **paint** in details using the paint tools

Drag on a **bubble for speech**. To move it around, click to select it (get the blue box) then put pointer in the middle and drag it. Also drag the origin near the characters mouth. There is a text box for narrator comments

Drag pictures to the page. To move them around, click to select the pic (get the blue box) then put pointer in the middle and drag it.

To get rid of any object – drag it to the bin

To resize a pic – drag a corner – but keep it the same shape
