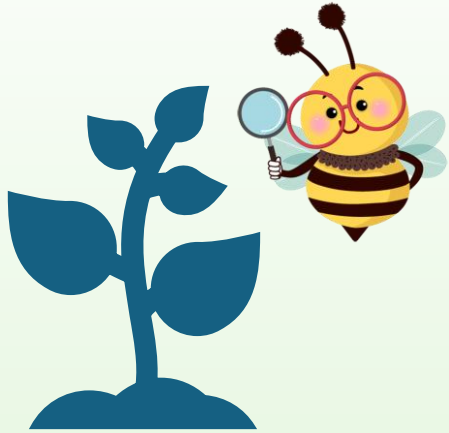

Summer 1: How Things Grow

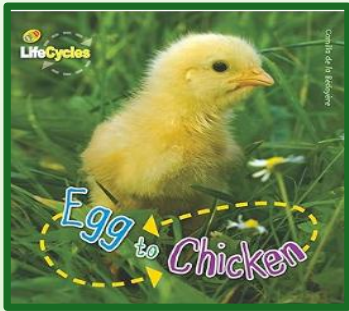
This half term we will be learning about how things grow!



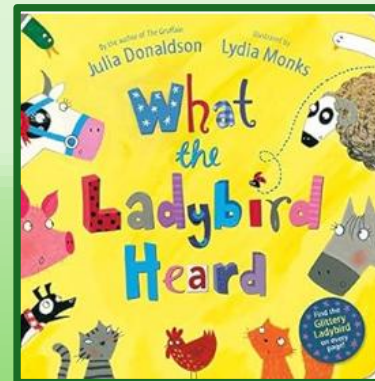
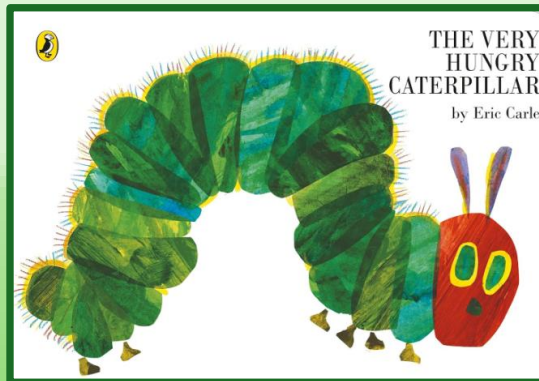
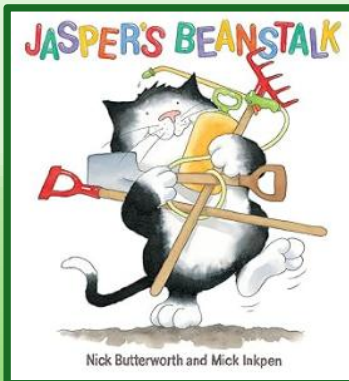
During this topic we will be learning about lifecycles of plants and minibeasts, looking at parts of a plant and growing plants!



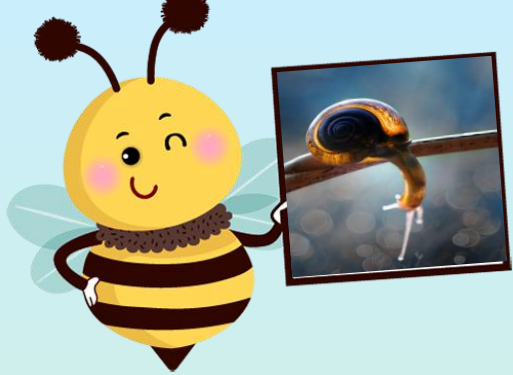
In our maths sessions we will be learning about the numbers past 10, up to 20. We will be building numbers, continuing number patterns and doing lots of verbal counting.



We will continue to have focus stories each week and will be helping the children to develop re-telling by remembering the beginning, middle and end of a story. Children will be encouraged to use and understand new vocabulary during discussions and in their work.
