Welcome back to the Summer Term! I hope you have all had a wonderful Easter.

As the Year 6 SATs are approaching, we will continue to prepare your children carefully. For the last two weeks prior to the tests, we will focus primarily on revision and on targeting areas where the children feel less confident. It is important that they do not feel overwhelmed outside of school. However, I would encourage the daily use of revision books, as these will support learning in school. Please ensure these are sent into school so that I can monitor progress.

Other subjects will continue to be taught in the afternoons, including PE (Tuesday and Wednesday), RE, and History/Geography.

All SATs papers will be taken during the morning.

To help the children feel as calm and settled as possible, we would like to invite them into school from 8:00am each morning during SATs week, so that we may share breakfast together. Breakfast will include toast with a variety of toppings, fruit, and juice. This will be followed by a short early morning revision session to ensure everyone feels positive and prepared for the upcoming tasks.

In past years, we have found that this has helped children feel more confident and able to achieve their very best.
