Travel Education Theatre

On Monday, Year 5 had a Travel Education Theatre Visit called 'Abbie Ayre and the Shed of Science'. It was a fun and engaging presentation educating and motivating pupils to help improve their local air quality safely and sustainably. They identified the causes and health consequences of poor air quality and to addressed ways in which they can avoid contributing to poor air quality, such as using sustainable transport. The children enjoyed learning more about air quality and sustainable transport through theatre, songs and games.
