### **Key information**

### **Reading**

Please continue to read as it is part of Year 2 homework. Please date and sign your child's diary every time you hear them read. Children do not need to finish their book in 1 day; they can read a few pages every night. If by Friday your child has been heard read 3 or more times in the week, they will receive 1 house point. We will monitor reading at home and will be reading with children during different points in the school year.

### **Homework**

Children should be practicing their spellings every week and should be reading with an adult at least 3 times a week. Children should be practicing their 2, 5 and 10 times tables on TTRS. There is also additional homework on our class page on the school website (optional).

### **Spellings - Friday**

New spellings will be available online weekly and spelling books will be returned by Friday. Spellings can be practised online throughout the week on <https://www.edshed.com/> using your child's login details.
